

MUSICAL STAFFET "Sound environments" PREMISE

The urban and natural environment in which each of us lives is constantly changing and so are its colours and sounds. At every moment of the day it shows over and over again a new image, which is unique and lasts for a short time. Take a break and listen carefully to your surroundings. Can you hear what it is whispering to you? Your home also represents your environment with its noises and sounds: are they male or female sounds? Can you tell them apart? PROJECT The project starts with a collection of the main and most characteristic sounds and noises in the area. Using a microphone and recording equipment, the different sounds will be "captured". A "soundtrack" will thus be constructed for the Italian schools that will participate in the musical relay race, arranging the different sounds collected in their cities.

PROJECT PHASES

- The project is aimed at secondary school pupils.
- A maximum of 1 product per school is allowed to participate.
- Starting from an incipit and a musical structure created by Maestro Claudio Patuto, the schools taking part in the initiative will work freely, respecting the following indications:
 - after recording the sounds or noises of the various areas of their environment, the school will "arrange" the piece and send it to info@spaziolegalita.it by uploading it on the portal, in the section dedicated to it. The second school, after listening to the piece of music, will in turn create the continuation. Unpublished texts written by pupils on the theme of gender equality can be included. Each school will wait until it has received the work of the previous school before continuing with its own, thus shaping the musical relay.
- The musical piece will have a duration of 4' 30" divided between the participating schools.
- Each school will have 1 month to work on its part.
- Applications must be received by 20 October 2021 and will be restricted to a maximum of 6 schools.
- Selection will be based on the order of arrival, which will be automatically recorded by the www.spaziolegalita.it platform.
- The project must be implemented in the period from 15 November 2021 to 15 May 2022
- All stages of the project will be supervised by Maestro Claudio Patuto
- Final product: the audio file created will be uploaded on the portal www.spaziolegalita.it and on all social networks. Participating schools will be allowed to upload the music on their websites and use it for school events.
- In addition, a final event will be held at the Santa Caterina Village in Scalea, Calabria, as part of the 4-day, 3-night thematic campus, where the students will be able to perform the piece of music together. The campus can be seen as a viable alternative to a school trip as the students will be involved in a range of practical sports activities by federal instructors and competent staff.
- The cost of the campus will be borne by the individual participants.
- Participation in the musical relay is not linked to participation in the final event.
